Where do people fit into the big picture?

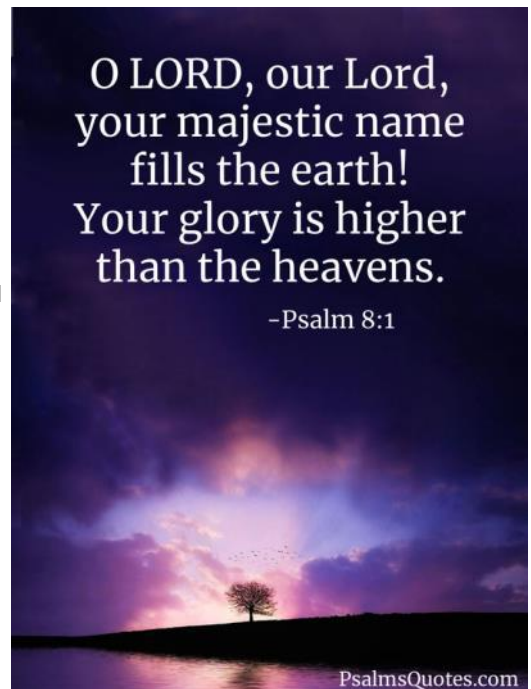

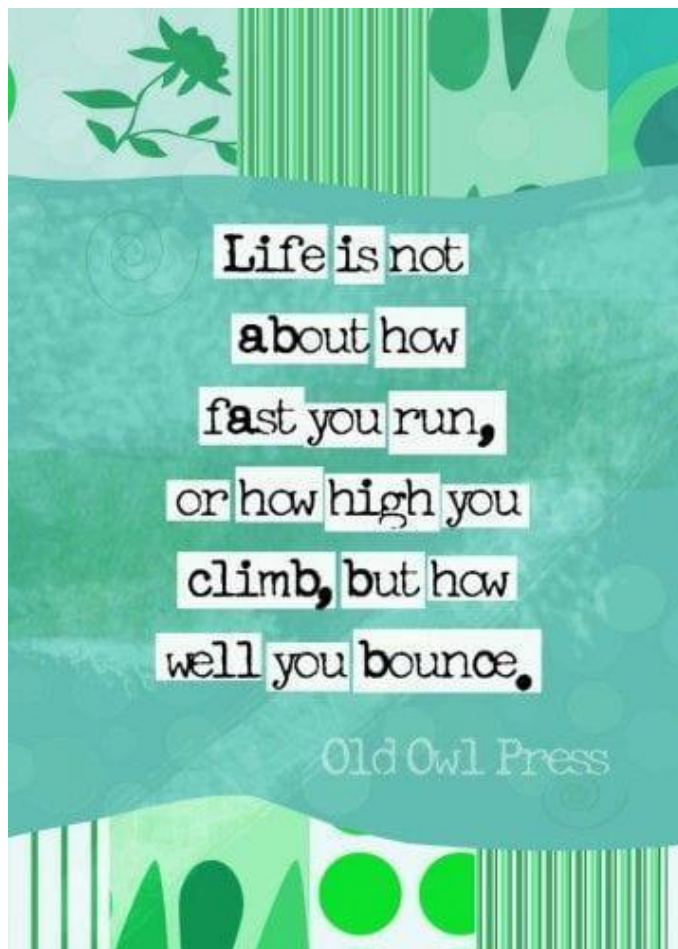
